The *Annual International* returns to the east coast in 2020, with Wave Hill, a spectacular public garden and cultural center overlooking the Hudson River and Palisades, collaborating with ASBA in producing and hosting the 23rd Annual International. Through innovative programs in horticulture, education and the arts, Wave Hill connects people to nature in meaningful and lasting ways. Its gardens, grounds and spectacular landscape provide a safe and welcoming place to be inspired and learn. A sketching day for artists is being planned for September 25, 2019, and Wave Hill will make available a list of plants in its collection as a reference for artists. We are looking forward to our return to Wave Hill and its beautiful Glyndor Gallery in the fall of next year! Please watch ASBA's website for more information.

Eligibility: open to all ASBA members in good standing, worldwide.

Submission Deadline: Materials received by **Friday, April 3, 2020.**

Jurors: TBA

Subject: Botanical specimens. Work may have appeared in regional exhibitions, but should not have been shown in another international juried exhibition of ASBA.

Media accepted: Two-dimensional original botanical art. No photography, no digitally generated work, and no three-dimensional work will be accepted.

Submissions: Three entries per artist will be accepted. Entry fee \$35 for the first entry, \$10 for each additional entry up to three.

Requirements: Images must be digital files only, 300 dpi X 8" high, tif or jpg, individual files labeled with artist's name and image title.

On Line Submission: Online entries only. Please see website at: <https://asba-art.org/information/enter-online>.

Presentation: Framed size limit 40" x 48", either horizontal or vertical. Accepted artists will be notified of framing requirements.

Notifications: Acceptances and regrets will be sent by May 15, 2020 by email. If accepted, artist ensures that artwork(s) will be available for display. If artist withdraws artwork before exhibition, artist will not be eligible to show at any ASBA exhibition for two years.

Sales of works: Artworks must be for sale and may not be removed until the close of exhibition.
